KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION 2008-2009

Kindergarten registration for next school year will be held at the District office located at 388 Clark Drive on the following dates:

April 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th

All registrations are by **APPOINTMENT ONLY**. Please call the District office at 474-4340 to set up an appointment.

To be eligible for next year's kindergarten, a child must have attained the age of five (5) years before October 1, 2008.

DOCUMENTS NEEDED FOR KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Certified copy of Birth Certificate (hospital records not acceptable)

Social Security Card – Make sure that name matches what is on birth certificate. If you do not have your child's card or the name doesn't match the birth certificate you will need to bring in a notarized document from the social security office stating that the social security number has been assigned to that child.

Immunization Records – Immunizations required:

DtaP/DTP/DT/Td – 5 doses, if the 4th dose was administered prior to their 4th birthday.

Polio – 4 doses of OPV or IPV

MMR – 2doses

Hepatitis B – 3 doses

Varicella – 1 dose

Proof of Residency- bring in one of the following documents:

1. Rental Lease Agreement
2. Rent Receipt with landlords name and phone number
3. Mortgage Coupon
4. Property Tax statement
5. Two current **utility bills** with your name and address on them

If parents are living with someone then they will need to get a **notarized proof of residency** form from the district office and have this paperwork notarized prior to registration. You will need to bring this document to your registration appointment.

Copy of Custody Orders, if parents are divorced or legally separated

If you do not have all the documents listed above when you come in for your appointment you won't be able to register that day. We will need to reschedule your appointment for a different day. Registration takes approximately 30 minutes. Due to limited space we request that just the parents attend registration. Assessments for the students will be held at a later date.
