# COMMUNITY OF CIRCLEVILLE

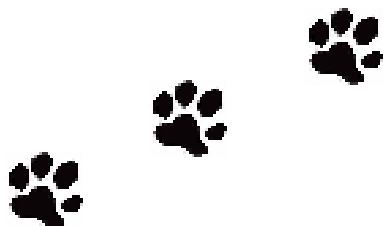
Circleville is a city of 13,485 located 25 miles south of Columbus at the junction of U.S. Routes 22 and 23. The economy is stable and based on small industry, agriculture and commerce.

Circleville High School is a comprehensive public high school that houses grades 9-12. CHS has a current enrollment of 740 students. Our senior class enrollment for the 2008-09 school year is 173.

The school year consists of two eighteen-week semesters. Courses are assigned credits based upon the "Carnegie Unit" system in accordance with Ohio Minimum Standards. CHS operates on nine-week grading periods. College preparatory, special education and regular education sequences are offered.

Four year college preparatory sequences are offered in English, mathematics and science. Spanish and German are also offered as electives. Honors classes are offered in English, chemistry, and mathematics. Advanced Placement (AP) courses are offered to students interested in English, American history, physics and calculus.

Approximately 35-40% of our graduating seniors choose to enter four-year post-high school institutions upon graduation from Circleville High School.
